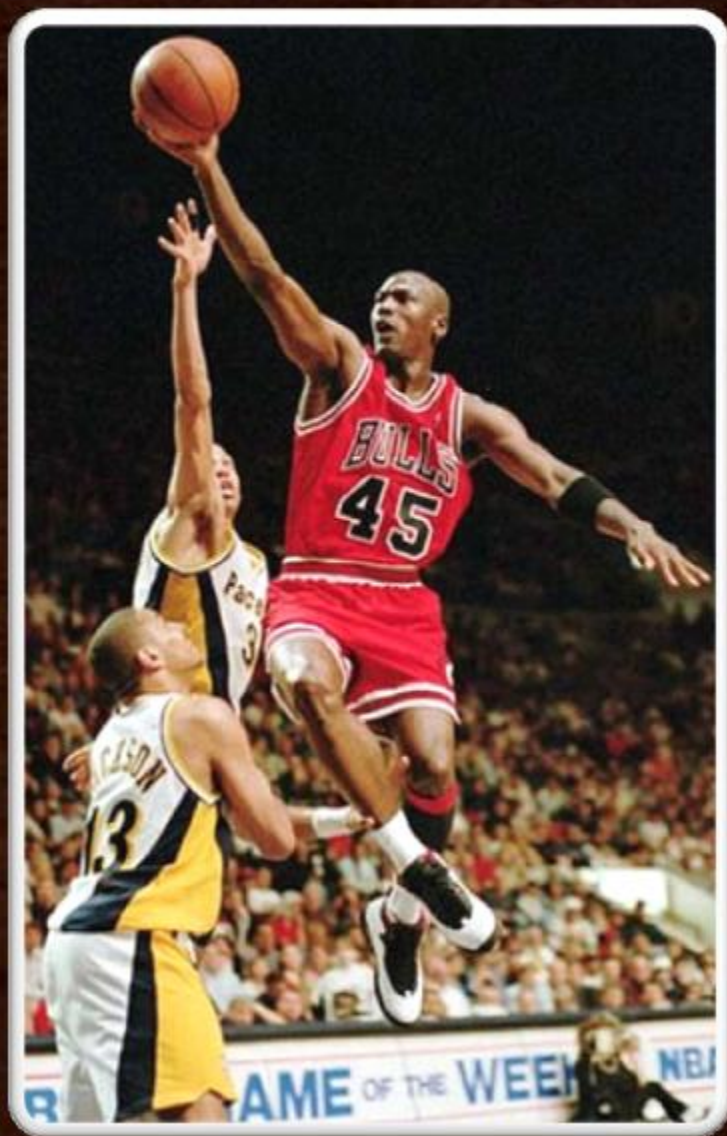
Why you should work hard at school

1. **To give you a choice of jobs** – the number of jobs you can get without any qualifications is shrinking **quickly**.
2. **To make sure you don't spend your life in a dead end job** – without qualifications, it is hard to move on from a low paid, low skilled job.
3. **To improve your earning power** – there is a big pay gap between people with qualifications and those without them. If you want a well-paid job, you need good qualifications.
4. **To show other people what you can do** – qualifications show employers, universities and colleges that you have the attitudes, skills and knowledge they value.
5. **To show yourself what you can do** – gaining qualifications boosts your self-confidence and self-awareness.

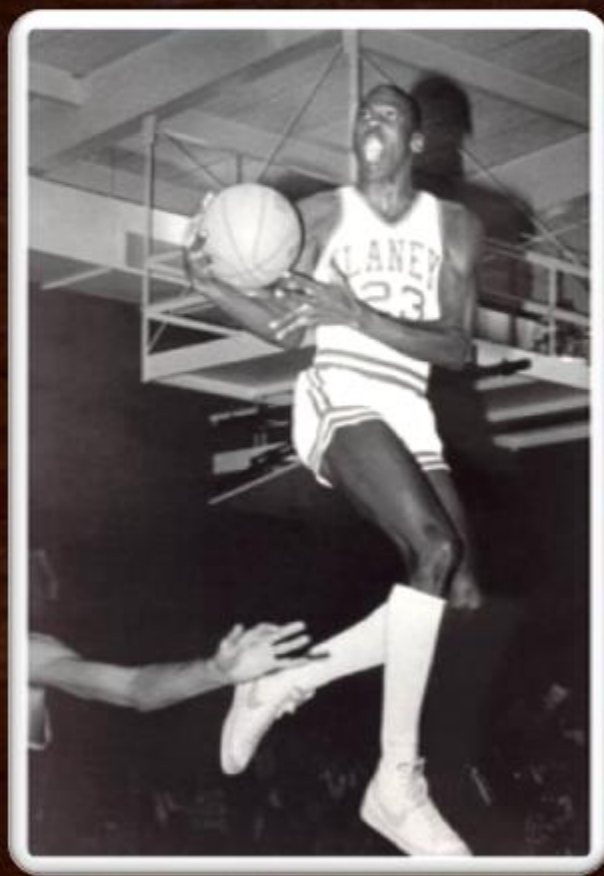

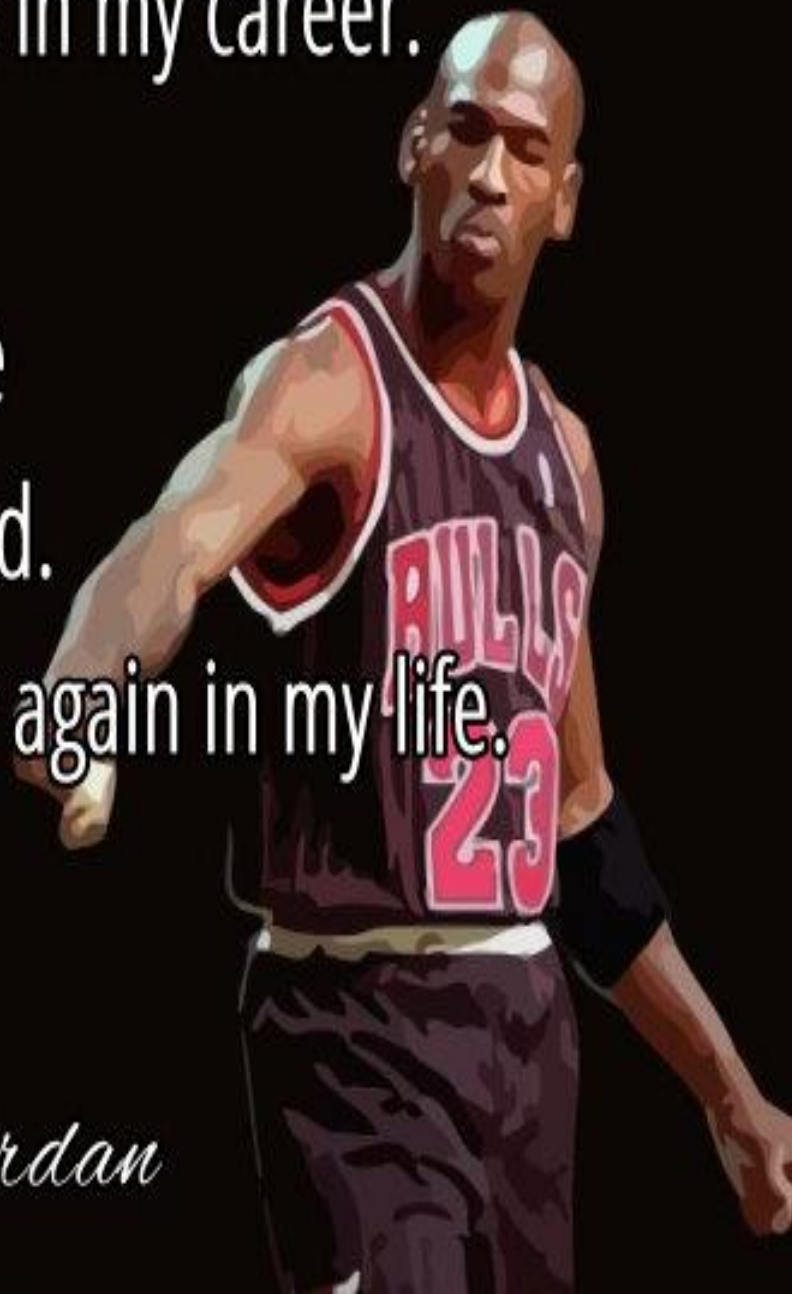
