A PowerPoint presentation and laser-cut monopoly board explaining why the role was chosen, its qualifications and skills.

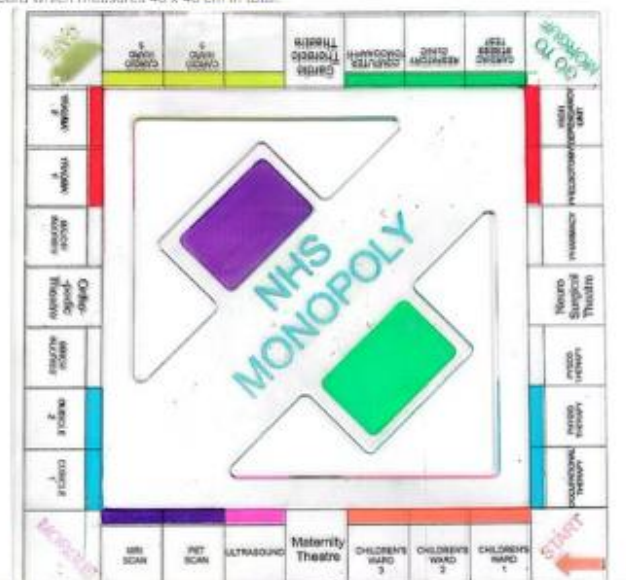
- You need to be a qualified and registered healthcare professional. Such as: midwife, doctor, etc. and be experienced within that role.

- Negotiating skills.



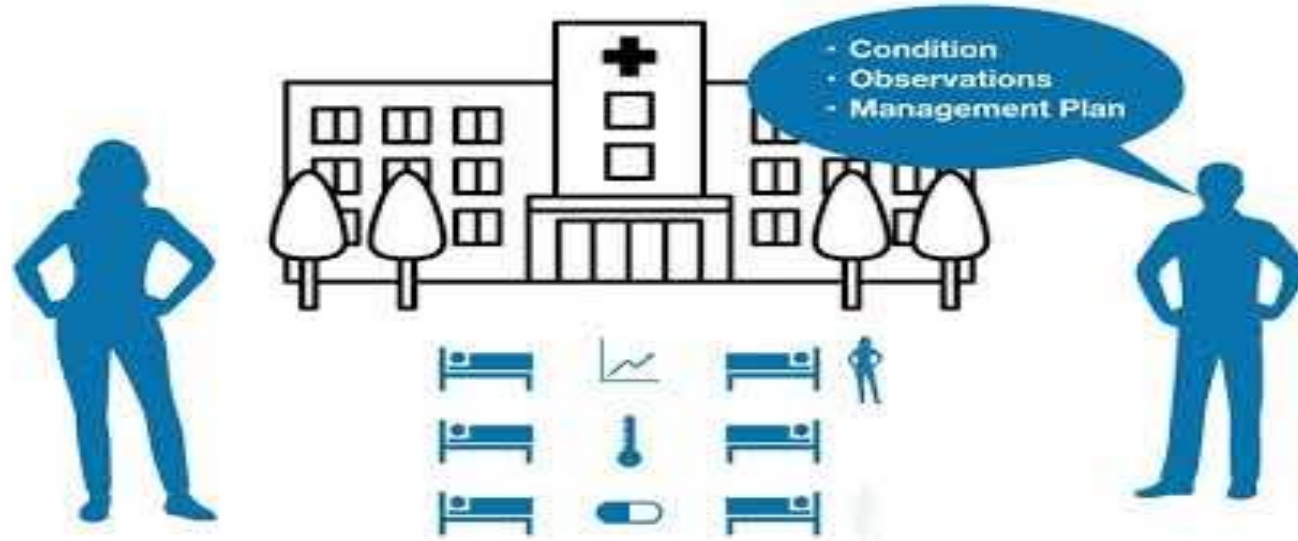

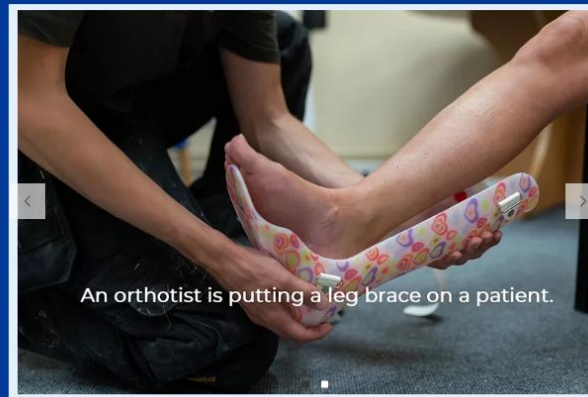

What is an Orthotist?

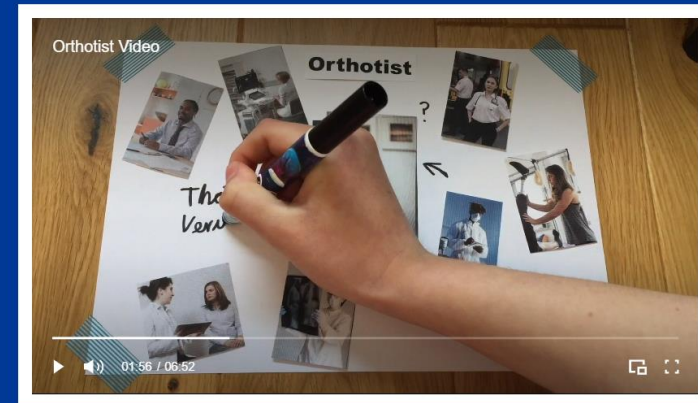
An Orthotist is a person who designs, makes and prescribes braces for the human body. They essentially give back the power of movement to their patients. They do this by using the latest technology to design and then make prostheses to fit their patient. The prostheses tend to be made out of mouldable plastic fibre which are easy to shape and then harden.

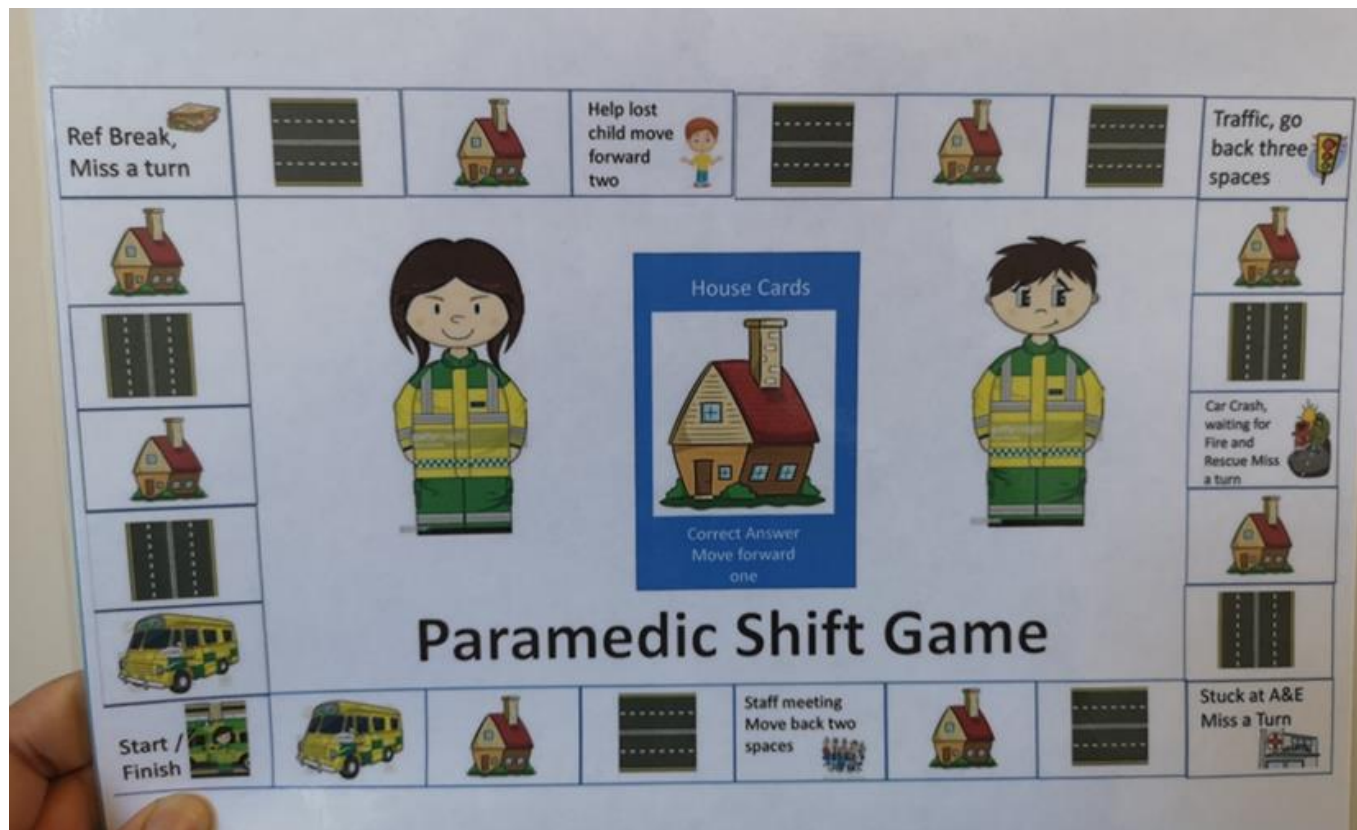

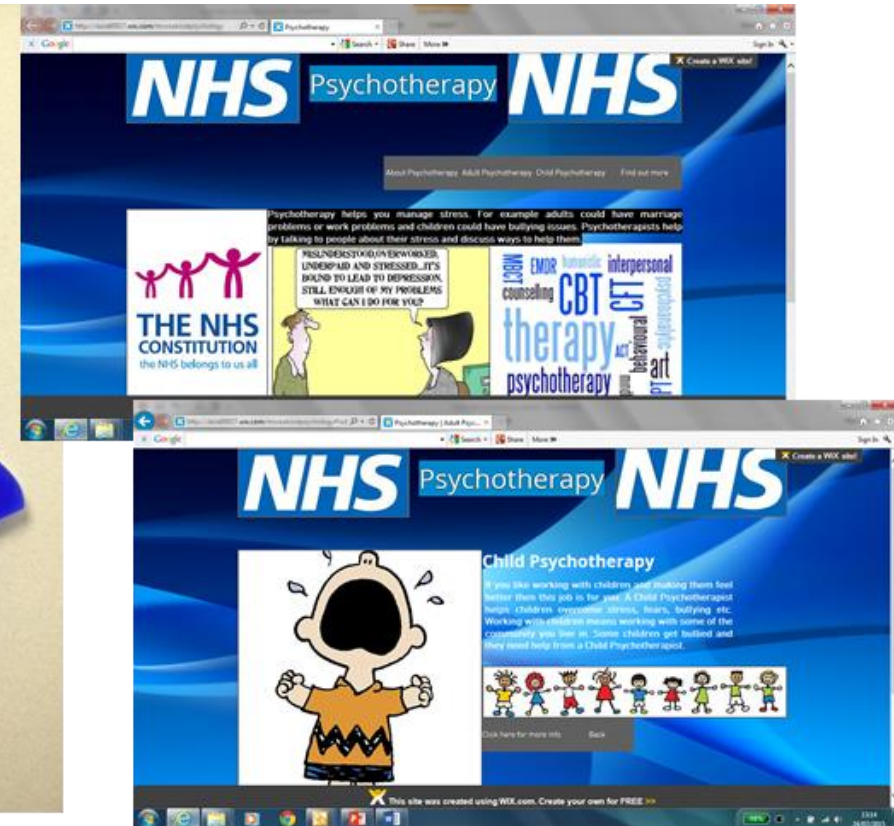
